



## HOLIDAY CURBSIDE COLLECTION SCHEDULE

A revised garbage, recycling and composting schedule is in effect for the upcoming statutory holidays. **The holiday schedule only impacts residents with Tuesday curbside collection.** There are no schedule changes for other residents and your collection day remains the same.

**There is no pick up on Christmas Day or New Year's Day**, both which fall on Tuesdays. On these days our offices will be closed so our staff can enjoy time with their families and loved ones.

- Christmas Day (Tuesday, December 25, 2018) pick up of blue carts and clear garbage will move to Sunday, December 23, 2018.
- New Year's Day (Tuesday, January 1, 2019) pick up of blue and green carts will move to Wednesday, January 2, 2019.

## HOLIDAY WASTE MANAGEMENT TIPS

- ✓ Reduce waste by wrapping gifts using reusable materials such as a scarf, dish towel, gift bags, boxes or tins.
- ✓ Wrapping paper and cardboard can go in your blue cart.
- ✓ Styrofoam packaging should go in the garbage.
- ✓ Once presents have been opened, set aside a box to collect ribbons, bows and other package decorations that can be reused in the future. If they are not suitable for reuse, ribbons and bows should be disposed of in the garbage.
- ✓ Plan to store and use your holiday leftovers.
- ✓ All food scraps should be put in the green (organics) cart.
- ✓ Donate unwanted holiday items including decorations and unopened treats to a local charity.
- ✓ Take old, unwanted electronics and small appliances to Chestermere's Recycle Depot, located on the grounds of the Chestermere Public Works yard at 281107 Township Road 243.
